- ▶ NT: collaborative workshop approach to the development of integrated assessment tools
- ➤ ACT: foundation skills and curriculum experts working in pairs to develop models for implementing integrated delivery of FSK units

Workforce Development Projects cont...

- ► **Tas**: developing and evaluating a workshop and assessment model for vocational practitioners to achieve TAELLN411
- ➤ SA: VET (Community Services) practitioners and LLN practitioners collaborating to build skills and develop strategies for implementing the FSK
- Qld: professional development pilots for VET in Schools providers and community based organisations to build capacity to deliver the FSK


