

# Australian Core Skills Framework (ACSF)

- 5 Core skills at 5 levels:
  - Learning
  - Reading
  - Writing
  - Oral Communication
  - Numeracy
- Consistent national approach to identifying core skills in different contexts
- Common reference point for describing and discussing


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- Performance grid
    - See table 2, page 8
      - Support
      - Context
      - Text
      - Task complexity

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- Identify the ACSF levels in a unit of competency
    - Activity:  
Identify the core skill requirements in the unit *BSBCMM201A Communicate in the workplace*
  - Align requirements to the relevant ACSF indicators



The bank includes:

- assessment tasks for levels 1-3 of the ACSF
- a user guide that describes how to use the tasks
- a report form.

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- Tasks are either industry specific or generic
    - See table on website
  - Generic tasks
    - Example: Write instructions
  - Industry specific tasks
    - Example: Use a floor plan
  - Tasks can be used as models
    - Example: ‘Complete a log’ tasks
    - Activity: Identify the ACSF indicators for each question
